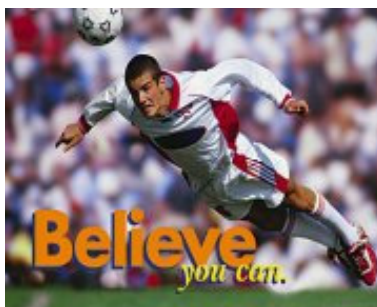
**Give your child a brighter future**
