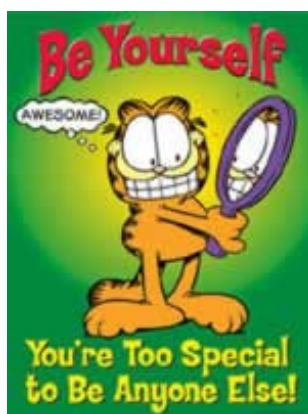
Give your child a brighter future
