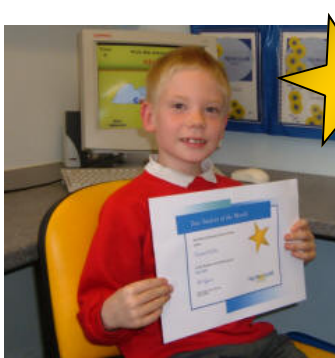


**May's Merit Awards;** judged on attendance, positive attitude and progress made in study.
