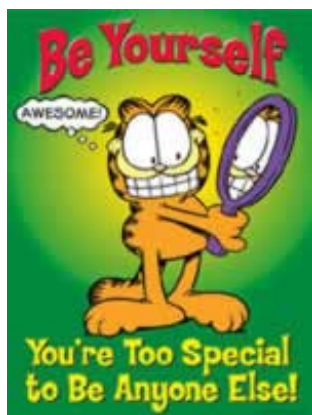


MARCH 2007 NEWSLETTER
