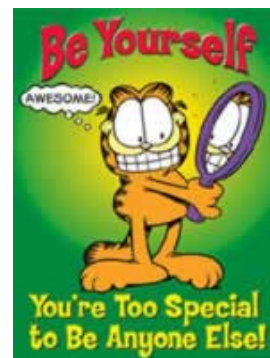




# MARCH 2008 NEWSLETTER

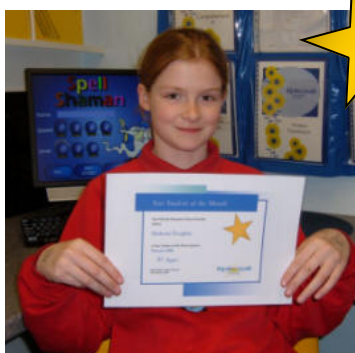


**February’s Merit Awards;** judged on attendance, attitude and progress made in study.

Junior **Star Bethany**



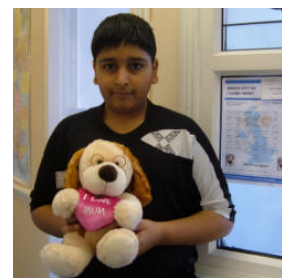
